

Leaving no one behind

Last year, our local teams drove, sailed, and trekked to rural places, reaching thousands of communities where women haven't had access to services like contraception and abortion care.

With a range of choices to avoid or space their pregnancies, we can bring women healthcare, hope and opportunities.

- 14 million people with little or no prior access to reproductive healthcare were supported by MSI teams
- 10 million kilometers traveled by MSI's mobile outreach teams, to reach the most marginalized people and remote communities with life-changing care
- 4.6 million vulnerable or displaced people supported by MSI in countries affected by climate disasters and humanitarian crises

Working with partners

In 2024, we partnered on long-term solutions, so that a client accessing a service today can expect high quality care in the years to come.

By working with governments and private health networks, investing in digital and expanding safe health products, we're building health systems that are more sustainable and resistant to changes in the global funding environment.



Changing lives and future generations

Our impact won't stay in 2024. The benefits of sexual and reproductive health and rights will ripple out for years, changing lives and generations.

A person's choice to access contraception or an abortion service can change the course of their life, and in some cases, it can save their life. It gives them control – whether that's to finish school, start a business, take on a leadership role, space their children, gain financial independence, or simply have agency to do whatever they choose.

- Every \$1 invested in contraception generates over \$120 in health and socio-economic gains
- In the countries MSI works in, pregnancy related deaths would be 15% higher without our programs
- Beyond abortion and contraception, MSI supported
 2.5 million people with other reproductive
 healthcare, including safe motherhood services
 and deliveries, and testing and treatment for cervical
 cancer and HIV
- 13,400 healthcare providers quality assured by MSI in 2024, so they have the skills to provide quality care for years to come

- 12,800 government health workers trained by MSI to provide quality reproductive choices in their communities, across 22 countries
- 8.2 million people accessed contraception or abortion services from government health facilities supported by MSI with training or supplies
- 11 advocacy wins were achieved by MSI and our partners, across the spheres of policy, law and finance, helping to secure reproductive rights
- 500+ partnerships helped us to expand services, strengthen health systems, advocate for change, share expertise and deliver impact – from grassroots to global

Supporting young people

We proudly supported millions of young people's futures and their ability to access education and opportunities.

Every young woman should have agency over her body and choices. Reproductive healthcare gives girls the ability to finish their education, embark on careers, and ultimately decide their own futures – helping to advance gender equality across the world.

- 2.6 million adolescents supported with reproductive choice, so they were able to pursue their own futures
- Nearly one in five clients (18%) served by MSI in 2024 was under 20 years old
- 600,000 adolescents supported to continue their education with access to reproductive choice



In 2024, our local teams in 36 countries across the globe delivered choice at scale for women and girls.

As a social business we generated around half of our income by selling health products and services. And our committed donors fueled our programs to reach marginalized and remote communities with no alternative access to care.

But the reality is hundreds of millions of women are still left behind, without the life-changing reproductive rights and choices they need, and recent cuts to international aid risk dragging us back further.

We know from our work around the world that the demand for reproductive choice has never been higher. Access to contraception and abortion will always be needed, and we are determined to be there for women, no matter what.
